Our School Budget

- Our school received \$4,405,778 in 2024-25 to provide a quality education to our students and meet the goals in our school development plan (SDP).
- At least 75 per cent of budgeted funds covers staffing and the remaining portion covers instructional and operational supplies.
- Literacy and numeracy classroom tools, manipulatives and resources
- Professional Development resources including First Aid certification for all staff
- •Technology maintenance (ie. Laptops, iPads, Chromebooks , Smartboards)
- Furniture for classrooms

- Student learning supplies (not covered by the student supplies fee) including art supplies
- •PE equipment, recess equipment, music equipment, library books
- Paper and printing costs
- Additional subs: assessments, additional support (EA's and teachers)

- •Student regulation tools (ie. Standing desks, wobbly stools, individual timers)
- •Restricted funds: subs, student supply fees, noon activity fee
- minor building maintenance and adjustments (adding coat hooks, adding bulletin boards, replacing or fixing damaged areas)


