### Relevant contextual information about JES and the JES School Development Plan:

- At Jennie Elliott we believe that Digital Citizenship (DC) is having the knowledge, skills, and attitudes needed to demonstrate responsible and respectful behaviour when using technology or participating in digital environments.
- At Jennie Elliott, our core belief is that our students should experience a greater sense of belonging, well-being and success at school, when the pathway to their learning is inclusive of all learners' needs.
- Student personal mobile devices are limited or restricted at all schools, unless required for health or medical needs, to support specialized learning needs, and for educational purposes.
- Our School Development Plan focuses on making learning accessible for all students by creating learning tasks that are universally accessible for all our learners including students with diverse learning needs.
- Each student has access to their classroom's online Google Classroom.
- Teachers plan daily for differentiated and personalized learning, including multiple means of expressing, representing and receiving information that can be supported through low, medium and high-tech tools.

### Relevant evidence and data that informs our JES Digital Citizenship Plan:

- Student devices: 76 iPads, 53 Chromebooks, 120 laptops.
- Each classroom houses 4 student devices for flexible, in-class, on demand use.
- 15% of our student population has a diagnosed exceptional learning or medical code that can benefit from assistive and instructional technology support.
- Main floor and upper floor have 2 laptop carts each with 25 devices available for sign-out as needed by teachers.
